Dear Kingdom Kids Families:

Your children's safety and health are of the utmost importance to us. With that in mind, our team is closely monitoring developments pertaining to the Coronavirus. We want to take this opportunity to provide precautionary steps for your children to take as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), so please see the following:

1. Encourage your child(ren) to wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, then use an alcohol-based hand rub with at least 60% alcohol;
2. If your child(ren) are sick, they should limit contact with others, remain at home, and see your physician;
3. If your child(ren) need to cough or sneeze, encourage them to cover their nose and mouth properly by using their inner-elbow;
4. Encourage your child(ren) to avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth to prevent the spread of germs;
5. Avoid close contact with people currently ill; and
6. Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with germs.

Likewise, our program is taking recommended steps including enhanced cleaning and sanitization measures. In addition, we will limit the use of shared items in our program.
